1. FILL

Each month fill your clean litter box 1.5–2 inches deep with LitterPearls® Micro Crystals cat litter.



2. LIFT-OUT

Remove and dispose of solid waste daily. Rake the micro crystals so the crystals are properly aerated and evenly distributed.



3. MAINTAIN

Add more micro crystals to maintain original depth. Replace micro crystals when they no longer control urine odor.

Most cats don't mind the different texture, but you may want to mix some of your cat's previous litter with LitterPearls® Micro Crystals on the first use.

To reduce tracking litter outside the box, we recommend a piece of carpet or a litter mat be placed at the litter box exit.

Note: Properly dispose of used cat litter and keep away from children. Particularly pregnant women and immunosuppressed persons should remember that cat feces can sometimes transmit a disease called toxoplasmosis. Always wash your hands after handling used cat litter. Unused litter poses no toxoplasmosis threat.
